PRE - APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE PROCESS

A FOUR STEP PROCESS:

STEP 1

DUAL-PHASE APPLICATION

15th October to 31st December 2024 (ordinary); 1st January to 31st January 2025 (extraordinary).

Pre-application is carried out online, via www.precandidaturas.estoril.salesianos.pt.

While submitting pre-application, the following documents must be sent via email to candidaturas@estoril.salesianos.pt with reference to the pre-application number:

- A Copy of the previous school's final assessment report for Preschool Education and Year 1 candidates (except students who haven't attended Pre-school).
- A Copy of all assessment reports from the academic year 2023/24.
- Other relevant documents which refer to the learning process (Medical or Psychological/Psychoeducational Reports).
- Cambridge Certificate (only for candidates who have attended a school with a Cambridge Protocol).

Please note that incomplete processes are not accepted, also applications delivered after the deadline are subject to unfilled vacancies.

STEP 1

OPEN DAY

11th January 2025 | Programme to be announced.

This step aims at providing important information about our school as well as to present the school's facilities to parents/guardians. 5th and 10th Grade candidates are expected to accompany their parents/guardians to the session and to complete an assessment task (the content will be shared with candidates in advance).

STEP 3

INTERVIEW

Interviews will begin/start on 4th November. Pre-school (3, 4 and 5 year olds), Primary, 2nd Cycle, Years 7 and 10 **will be scheduled** by Parents/Guardians during the pre-application. Parents/Guardians as well as the applicant must be present at the interview.

For other grades (8th, 9th, 11th, 12th), the school will contact the Parents/Guardians of the candidate, **regarding the available vacancies**.

STEP 4

SCREENING AND ACCEPTANCE

After the interview, acceptance will occur according to the following criteria:

If the applicant,

- has a brother or sister studying at Salesianos do Estoril;
- is the son or daughter of an employee at Salesianos do Estoril;
- is the brother or sister of a former student at Salesianos do Estoril;
- is the son or daughter of a former student at Salesianos do Estoril;
- attends an extracurricular activity at Salesianos do Estoril;
- attends a school with a protocol established with Salesianos do Estoril.

The acceptance will be communicated **via email**. Candidates who are not admitted will be informed **via email, as well**. Communication dates may differ for different grades:

- Acceptance for Preschool (3, 4 and 5 year olds), Primary, 2nd Cycle and Year 7: will be communicated by January 13th.
- For other school years, the school will contact the Parents/Guardians of the candidate, regarding the available vacancies.

ADMITTED STUDENTS:

REGISTRATION:

Registration must be completed online (www.candidaturas.estoril.salesianos.p).

Payment can be done at the School Office, by bank transfer or MBWay within two working days, after telephone contact. After the deadline, the vacancy will be automatically available to other candidates.

ENROLLMENT:

Enrollment takes place in June/July (email address will be sent later). Payment can be performed at the School Office by bank transfer or MBWay within two working days.

Please be advised that the annual fee consists of registration, enrollment and 9 monthly payments. In Preschool Education, there are 10 monthly payments. Registration or Enrollment fees are not refundable. The school office remains available to answer any questions or provide further information if needed.

NOTE: If the information provided is either incorrect or not accurate, the application process must be considered for annulment.
